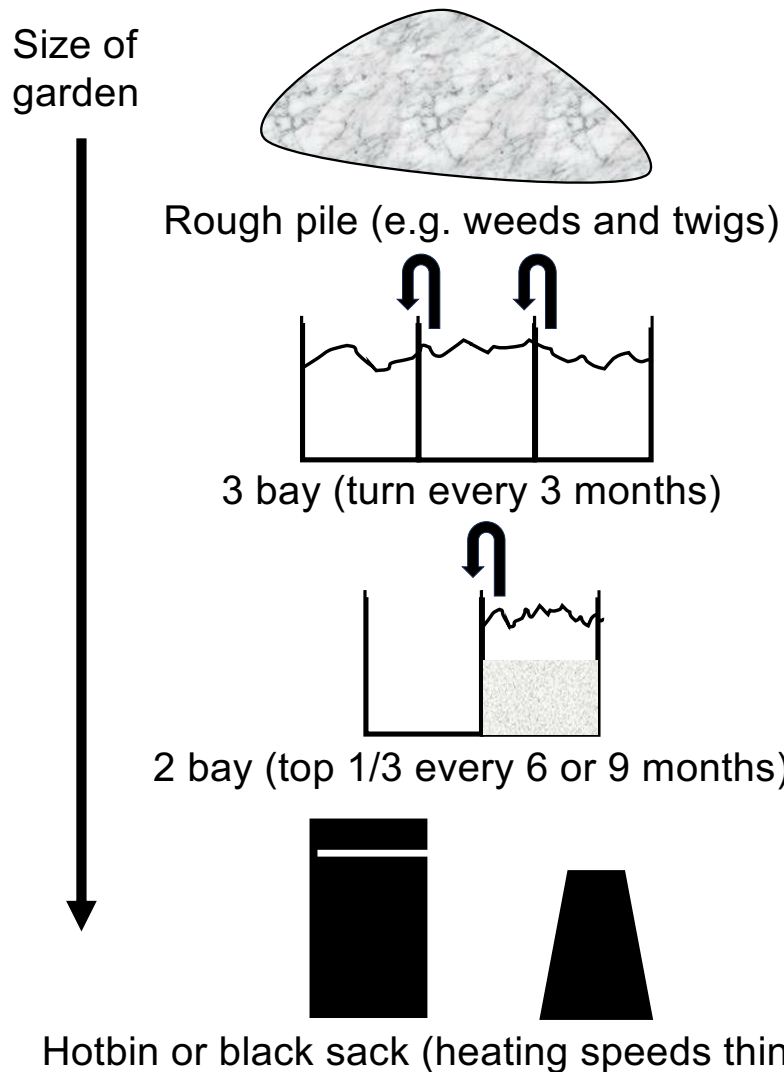

Garn Gwych – paned a sgwrs am gompostio



- Optimal ratio is 2-3 parts brown (C) to 1 part green (N)
- Brown: paper/cardboard, dry leaves, wood chips, straw...
- Too much brown – slows decomposition, pile too dry
- Green: veg peelings, grass cuttings, coffee grounds, eggshells...
- Too much green – becomes soggy, smells
- Bays need to be large enough to become warm (3x3x3 foot min)
- Turn frequently for fast composting, turn after temperature has peaked, or adjust according to usage
- Turning aerates compost - helps microbes, but reduces insulation
- Water if needed
